A Year of Impact at the Bullhead Regional Food Bank

As we look back on the past year, we are proud of the meaningful impact made by the Bullhead Regional Food Bank in partnership with our community. Responding to hunger is not just about food—it is about access, dignity, and ensuring our neighbors feel supported during difficult times.

Throughout the 2025 year, the Food Bank processed 2,605,114 pounds of food to 85,610 individuals and families across our service area. These efforts supported seniors on fixed incomes, working families, and children who rely on consistent access to nutritious food. This impact is possible because of our dedicated volunteers, who are the heart of our operation. With the generosity of people who give of themselves and their time, volunteers contributed 22,781 hours to sorting, packing, and distributing food. Their commitment allows the Food Bank to operate efficiently while maximizing every donated dollar.
